Job Responsibilities of NaCSA Cluster of Excellence Coordinator

1. Ensure strict adherence to Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) across designated clusters/societies identified as Clusters of Excellence. Maintain regular coordination with NaCSA to monitor and report on crop status.
2. Collaborate with NaCSA and farmers at least two months prior to the cropping season to develop a comprehensive crop plan. Engage both cluster/society farmers and neighbouring farmers from proposed antibiotic-free and disease-free zones.
3. Provide hands-on technical guidance to farmers on aquaculture practices, including pond preparation, water quality management, feed management, and disease prevention, in collaboration with NaCSA.
4. Organize and oversee the weekly sampling of ponds in coordination with NaCSA.
5. Maintain up-to-date records on pond preparation, water quality, feed management, and farm input usage. Ensure accurate documentation and timely submission of reports to the NaCSA Head Office.
6. Conduct regular meetings with farmers to review crop status and organize awareness programs on the harmful effects of banned antibiotics during the culture period, with NaCSA support.
7. Coordinate and arrange all necessary sampling activities during official visits to the clusters.
8. Assist in forming a 5-member farmer committee responsible for monitoring farm activities. Support bi-weekly farmer meetings (with NaCSA technical staff presence), ensure documentation of discussions and decisions, and obtain signatures from all participants.
9. Coordinate the execution of pre-harvest testing before the harvest.
10. Assist in planning and arranging common harvest infrastructure such as chill-killing tubs, electronic weighing machines, and other logistics in coordination with NaCSA.

Other terms & conditions:

1. The selected candidates must stay near the aquafarm cluster during the engagement period.
2. Under no circumstances the contract term will be extended.
3. The selected candidate has no right to claim any type of permanent employment in the NaCSA, the Marine Products Export Development Authority (MPEDA) or in any other MPEDA societies.
4. The selected candidate is bound by the prevailing rules and regulations of the Authority and Government of India with regard to his/her service, conduct and character, and including the matters of confidential nature.
